

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF NCCEOP?

The purpose of NCCEOP is to bring together into a work and study community those persons who have active interest in or who are professionally involved in broadening accessibility to and success in formal post-secondary education. The major focus is two-fold:

1. To provide services that prepare students for post-secondary educational experience; and
2. To facilitate institutional responses to the challenge of serving more diverse populations.

WHAT ARE THE OBJECTIVES OF NCCEOP?

To engage in coordinated efforts with other organizations and persons having purposes supportive of or in harmony with NCCEOP.

To promote research, evaluation, fiscal planning, and overall program development, which will enable members to strengthen their advocacy of educational opportunities for low-income students.

To encourage the development and expansion of a communication network primarily for those persons professionally involved in educational opportunity programs.

WHAT DOES NCCEOP DO?

- Stimulates and educates the general public on critical issues.
- Sponsors workshops to improve education services in educational opportunity programs.
- Sponsors annual state conferences.
- Sponsors a statewide Scholar's Bowl that includes participation by students from the affiliated Upward Bound Programs.
- Publishes a regular Council Newsletter.
- Engages in research and encourages individuals to present papers on educational trends and policies.
- Provides technical assistance to its members.
- Sponsors a scholarship program for TRIO recipients.
